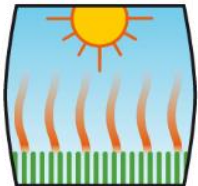

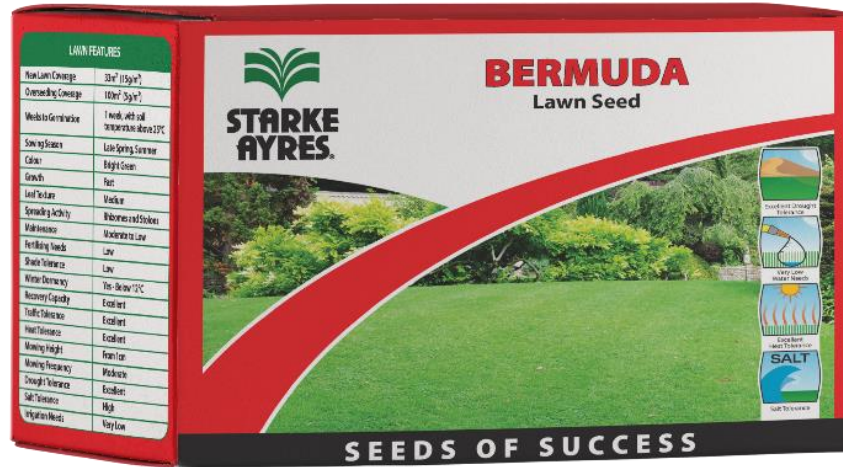
Very Low Water Needs

BERMUDA

Cynodon Dactylon

Bermuda is a warm season grass adapted to a wide range of soils. Bermuda goes dormant in winter (below 12°C). Lateral growth by stolons and rhizomes. Highly tolerant to heat, salt, drought and traffic conditions.

Weeks to Germination	1 week, with soil temperature above 25°C
Sowing Season	Late Spring, Summer
Colour	Bright Green
